# BETTY LAKE - NEW CABIN

Construction of a new cabin (24' X 36') was completed on Betty Lake this past September. This cabin has three separate bedrooms (knotty pine throughout), indoor shower with hot/cold running water, huge kitchen/cooking area, fully operational solar lighting system (May, 2005) and a large deck overlooking the lake. # COMMUNICATIONS

Believe it or not satellite telephones were in demand in the 2004 season. They will again be available in 2005 at \$25/day + \$2/minute/call + taxes. A gentle reminder: don't wait - reserve NOW- we only have two (2) satellite phones.

#### LAKE WATER

According to the Ontario Government "... if water is not treated it cannot be considered potable." In short, if you don't treat the water you should not drink it. So, what do you do? There are lots of choices but the easiest is to simply disregard the warning and get on with your life. However, if you are really, really concerned about the lake water then consider the following options: bring bottled water; boil the water; put a couple of drops of bleach in the water & let stand for 20 minutes. We have "posted" these instructions in all of our cabins (government requirement).

The "big ticket items" (e.g., aviation gas, outboard gas, insurance, new construction, dollar exchange rates, etc.) continue to rise. As a result we have had to adjust our prices accordingly. # **DEPOSITS**

Our new deposit requirement – \$200/person. Due to Revenue Canada regulations we are able to rebate a portion of your GST provided the deposits increase as trip prices increase.

# Taxes: Provincial & Federal

Provincial taxes (PST) and Federal taxes (GST) are collected on each package that we offer. After all the "dust settles" the  $\underline{total}$  amount of tax approximates 8%.

# BIG FISH

Can you believe a  $48\frac{1}{2}$ " northern pike? How about a  $31\frac{1}{2}$ "walleye? These were some of the largest fish <u>caught and released</u> on our lakes during the 2004 fishing season. Rick Lindberg (WI) & Tim Rice (MN) caught a big pike while Judith Gast (TX) and Scott Endicott (MN) caught the largest walleyes in '04. CONGRATULATIONS!

# Moose Hunts

The 2005 season will be the 17<sup>th</sup> season that we have been outfitting for moose hunts in NW Ontario. In the past, hunts were full-guided; however, with the 2005 season "guides" will be optional thus making the price of the hunt extremely competitive with other big game hunts in North America. Interested? Give us a call since "moose tags" are limited.

### **Fish Licenses & Fish Limits**

There are two basic fishing licenses in Ontario: regular & conservation. Regular license allows, in possession, 4 walleye, 4 northern pike & 2 lake trout; conservation license allows 2 walleye, 2 northern pike & 1 lake trout. NO TROPHY FISH ALLOWED.

# DEAR GUEST - PLEASE HELP US!

(Let's make life easier for each other)

<u>Please DON'T</u> put BBQ/ fish cooker on the deckgrease spills are a messy, tough to clean up, create accidents & invites bears into the cabin. <u>Please DON'T</u> piss off of cabin decks - it stinks! And, nobody, NOBODY, appreciates it.

<u>Please DON'T</u> bring coolers with wheels - they are extremely difficult to load and unload.

<u>Please PULL</u> boats/motors onto the boat ramps because they are easier to clean & eliminate problems for aircraft tie-up at the dock.

<u>Please CLEAN</u> your cabin, wash the dishes, sweep the floor & pick up garbage around the camp. We know that YOU like a clean cabin - so does the next group.

<u>Please BE READY</u> to depart on your pick-up day. Aircraft may be at the outpost camp as early as 6:30 a.m. Flying schedules, weather, passenger loads & seasonality effect daily flight schedules. So, BE READY! We do THANK YOU!

Did you know that Canadian walleye (stizostedion vitreum) spawn at night over gravel in shallow, rocky, fast flowing waters during April - May and that only 1 of 10,000 hatched young walleye will survive after the first year.
